Religious How-To's

REGARDING IHRAM

- **One who is in ihram may change his clothing**
- **One who is in ihram may shower**
- **One who is in ihram may touch their own skin**
- **One who is in ihram may use a blanket**
- **One who is in ihram may wear sunglasses**
- **Women may wear colors other than white**
- **Making a mistake in the ihram does not cause the ihram to “break,” rather you incur a penalty**

FASTING ON THE DAY OF ARAFAH

Misconception:

Hujjaj should fast on the day of Arafah

Truth:

Hujjaj should focus on making dua on the day of Arafah rather than spending their strength in fasting



CLIPPING THE HAIR

Misconception:

One who is in ihram may not clip his/her own hair get out of Ihram

Truth:

One who is in ihram may clip his/her own hair get out of Ihram



TIME OF TAWAAF

Misconception:

**One must perform tawaaf al ziyarah
on the 10th of Dhul hijjah**

Truth:

**One may perform tawaaf al ziyarah
on the 10th-12th of Dhul hijjah**
